



## **Barricade Scoot and Shoot**

### **Application:**

Using tactical rifle while shooting from varied positions and moving as quickly as practical while maintaining accuracy.

### **Objective:**

To test the shooter's ability to shoot from barricades utilizing non-traditional shooting positions.

**Rounds:** 64 rifle, pistol as necessary. Targets: B27.

**Load:** Enough magazines to load the required 64 rifle rounds.

Duty pistol with magazines and rounds to transition if necessary.

### **Course:**

- With rifle loaded, chamber empty, shooters will start at 50 yd line, then move to 40 yd line.
- Shooters will stop at first 4-step barricade, chamber a round and fire 2 rounds at each of the 2 targets down range. There are eight shooting positions. 32 rounds total; 16 rounds on each target.
- Shooters will then make the weapon safe and move to the next 4-step barricade at the 25 yd line and fire the same course from that barricade. Again, 32 rounds total; 16 rounds on each target.

### **Scoring:**

Time and accuracy (number of hits), 5 seconds are added to shooter's time for each miss.
